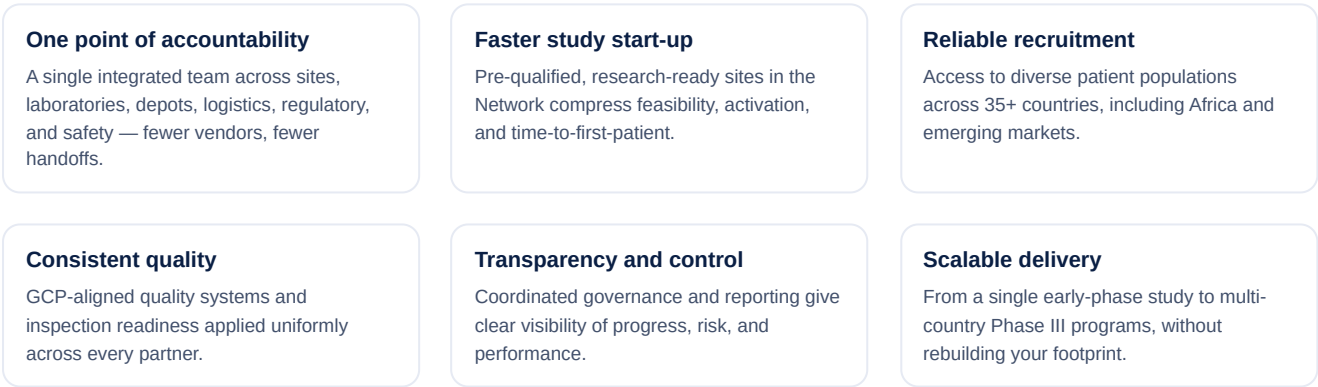

Institute creates knowledge. Academy develops people. The Network connects the ecosystem. Solutions deliver the work.

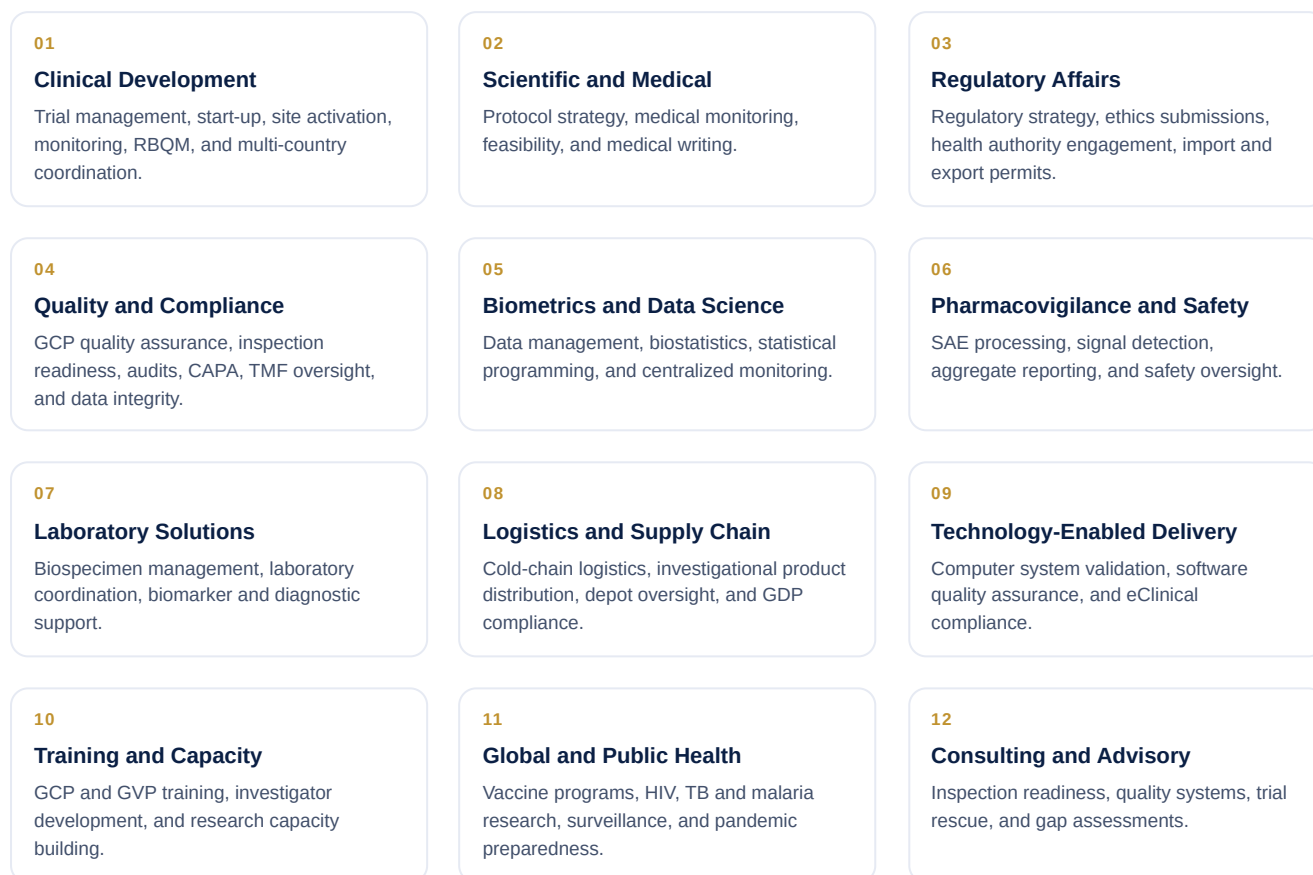

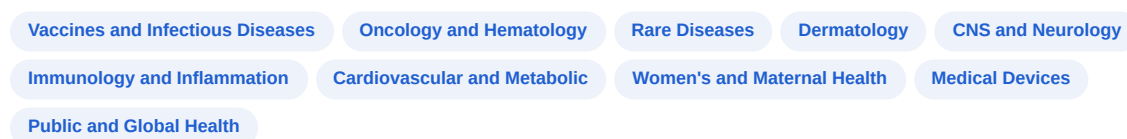

AE-PCRN · African Early Phase Clinical Research

The Africa-focused Center of Excellence dedicated to early-phase clinical research, translational medicine, vaccine innovation, and epidemic and pandemic preparedness — strengthening Africa's capacity through investigator development, site capacity building, and regional collaboration. Advised by an independent Scientific Advisory Board.

Additional Centers of Excellence will extend this model into oncology, vaccines, medical devices, precision medicine, and other priority areas.
